



REGULATIONS REGARDING THE FEES PAYABLE BY SOCIAL WORKERS,

STUDENT SOCIAL WORKERS AND SOCIAL AUXILIARY WORKERS.

The Minister of Social Development has, in terms of section 28 of the Social Services Professions Act, 1978 (Act 110 of 1978), on the recommendations of the South African Council for Social Service Professions, made the Regulations set out in the Schedule hereto:

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these Regulations "The Act" means the Social Service Professions Act, 1978 (Act 110 of 1978), and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear that the meaning, unless the context otherwise indicates.

Fees payable to the Council

- 2. (a) The following fees shall be paid to the Council by **social workers:**
 - (i) Registration fee by applicants who obtained their qualifications at a training institution in the RSA.....R210.00

- (h) The Annual Fee referred to in paragraphs (a) (vi), (b) (iv) and (d) (vi) shall:-
 - (i) subject to the provisions of the subparagraphs (ii) and (iii) be paid on or before 1 January of every year;
 - (ii) in the case of a person who is registered for the first time as social worker or a social auxiliary worker or a social worker registering a speciality in terms of the Act be calculated pro rata for the period extending from the first day of the month during which he or she is registered to the end of the financial year concerned, and be paid in full for the year concerned before such person's name is entered in the register;
 - (iii) in the case of a person who applies for registration in terms of section 22(4) of the Act or whose name is restored in terms of section 20(3) of the Act to a register referred to in section 19(1) of the Act, be calculated pro rata for the period extending from the first day of the month during which the person's name is restored to the register to the end of the financial year concerned and be payable before such person's name is restored to the register: Provided that, in the case of a person whose name has been removed from the register in terms of section 20(1)(d) of the Act and such person has proceeded to practice as a social worker, the annual fee be paid in full for the current financial year as well as an *additional amount* of R400.00 in the case of social auxiliary workers before such person's name can be restored to the register concerned.
- (h) The fees referred to in these Regulations include Value Added Tax.

Reservation

- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a)(vi), (b)(iv) and (d)(vi) of Regulation 2
 - (a) Any persons who in the course of any financial year attains the age of 65 years on or before 31 March of that financial year shall be exempted from the payment of annual fees for the following financial years; however still be allowed to practice if he/she so wish to.
 - (b) Any person who in the opinion of the Council does not practice the profession of social work or social auxiliary work because of health reasons and who has applied in writing to the Council for exemption of payment of the annual fee shall, for the period and on the conditions determined by the Council, be exempted from the payment of annual fees; and `
 - (c) Any person who in the course of any financial year ceases to practice the profession of social work or social auxiliary work on or before 31 March of that financial year and who applies in writing to the Council for exemption shall be exempted from the following financial year of the full payment of the annual fees and shall pay only an amount which is calculated to be 50 percent of the annual fees: Provided that **before** reentering the profession such a person shall inform the Council in writing of such intention and shall pay the outstanding pro rata annual fees calculated from the first day of the month of re-entry to the profession, within twenty-one days after being notified of the amount payable, after which the said exemption shall fall away.

Repeal

 The Regulation made under the Social Service Professions Act, 1978, published as Government Notice No. R 738 in Government Gazette No. 32397 of 17 July 2009 is hereby repealed.

Commencement

5. These regulations shall come into effect on the date of publication of the notice.

DECLARATION STATE FORESTS IN MPUMALANGA AS FOREST NATURE RESERVES UNDER SECTION 8(1) OF THE NATIONAL FORESTS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1998)

By virtue of powers vested in me under Section 8(1) of the National Forests Act,1998 (Act No 84 of 1998) hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), I, Tina Joemat-Pettersson, Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries hereby declare State forest properties in Mpumalanga as forest nature reserves as set out in Schedule A.

The effect of this declaration is that in terms of Section 10(1) of the Act, no person may cut, disturb damage or destroy any forest produced in, or remove or receive any forest produce from, a protected area, except under rules made for the proper management of the area, servitude right, license or exemption granted by the Minister.

A person who contravenes this declaration, commits a second category offence in terms of section 62(2)(a) of the Act and is liable on a first conviction for that offence to a fine or imprisonment for a period of up to two years, or to both a fine and such imprisonment.

MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES ACT, 1965 (ACT 101 OF 1965)

SCHEDULES

The Minister of Health has, in terms of section 22A(2) of the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act 101 of 1965), on the recommendation of the Medicines Control Council, made and updated the Schedules to allow for Emergency Medical Care Providers registered as a Paramedic or a Emergency Care Practitioner under the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974), Dental Therapists registered under the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974) and Optometrists registered under the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act 56 of 1974) to prescribe and supply, only within his/her scope of practice and subject to the indication for use of such substances and medicines and to the conditions determined by the Medicines Control Council, to patients under his/her care, Scheduled substances and medicines provided for in the Annexures to the Schedules.

This Schedules amends the Schedules as published in Government Gazette Notice 227 (Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act 101 of 1965)): Government Gazette 35149, 15 March 2012.

In these Schedules, "the Act" means the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act 101 of 1965)
